It is mandated that examinees strictly adhere to stipulated Instructions:

(A) Instructions to Examinees:

1.	Reach the Test Centre as per the Reporting/Entry time stated on your Admit Card. Wait

	in a queue for Frisking for entry. Any violation of this can debar you from entry.
-	After ending of the reporting time, NO examinees will allow entry in the center.
2.	No Examinees would be allowed to enter the Examination Centre, without Admit
	Card, Valid ID Proof and proper manual frisking.
3.	Examinees are NOT allowed to carry any personal belongings including
	MOBILE PHONE, Electronic Devices any type of eatable items in the examination
	center. There is no storage facility at the exam center.
4.	Seating plan with room number is printed on your admit card. Make a note of it.
	Seating plan will not be displayed at the Test Centre to avoid crowding.
5.	As per the JLPT rule and policy alternative day and time can't be assigned for JLPT
	July-2024 examination to disallowed examinees.
6.	Examinees will not be allowed to leave the examination hall before end time of
	examination. On completion of the examination, please wait for instructions from
	Invigilator and do not get up from your seat until advised.
7.	You may use the Test center toilet before entering in the Test room. Going to toilet
	during the Test time is not allowed.
8.	Please note "MOSAI, New Delhi" will not be responsible for any loss of examinees
	belongings kept outside the Test Room/Centre.
9.	There is no parking space at the Test Centre. To stopping or parking of personal vehicle
	is strictly not allowed in front of entry or exit gates. It is advisable to use public
	transport.
